

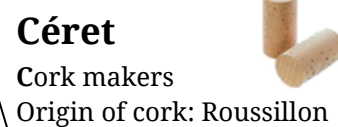

### Cap cork

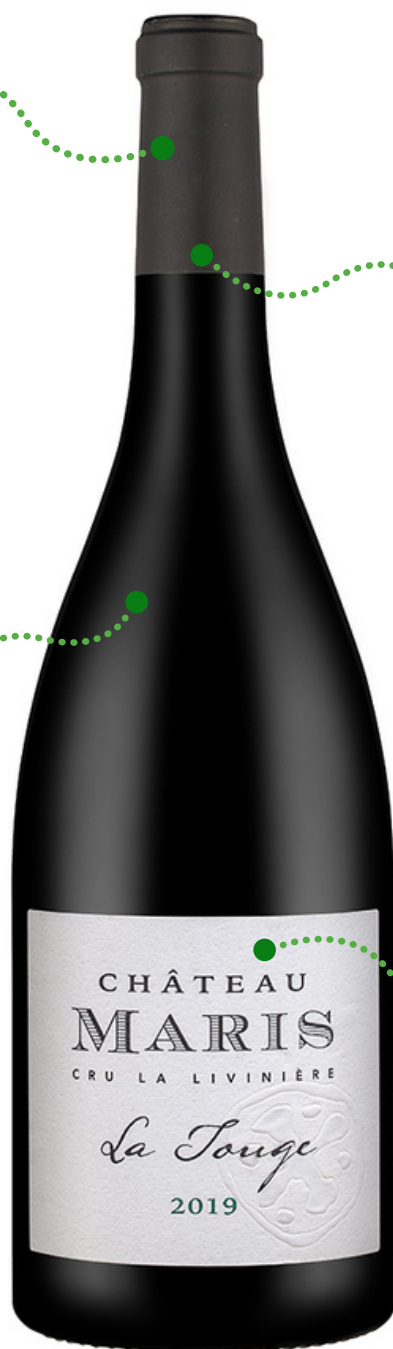
- Cork is 100% natural and infinitely recyclable.
- Cork stoppers help improve the wine industry's carbon footprint. Cork oak forests are true carbon sinks and contribute to biodiversity.
- Our corks come from French and Portuguese cork forests.

### The bottle glass

- A reusable and infinitely recyclable material
- Our bottles contain 85% recycled glass

### The label in paper

- Our labels are made from recycled paper
